Venice Orientation tour (start directly from your Venice hotel)

I can pick you up directly by the cruise terminal, hotel or stay and cover the area of the Jewish quarter, then continue in the area of Rialto bridge and fish and fruit market (which is closed on Sunday and Monday), we will discover and learn the story of Marco Polo and his great trip to China, I'll show you some great view point and I'll tell you something about the Venetian legends, we will see the area of St John and St Paul with a lovely stop in an incredible book store in Parisian "Shakespeare&co" style.

After a nice walk through St Mark Sq, we will reach "scala del Bovolo" a nice mix among a lovely staircase (which looks like a snail) and Pisa leaning tower. We will see Mozart's house, Fenice Opera House, and finish our tour by Grand Canal with a lovely view on Guggenheim museum (this is an example of itinerary; after that, we can customize it according to your wishes).

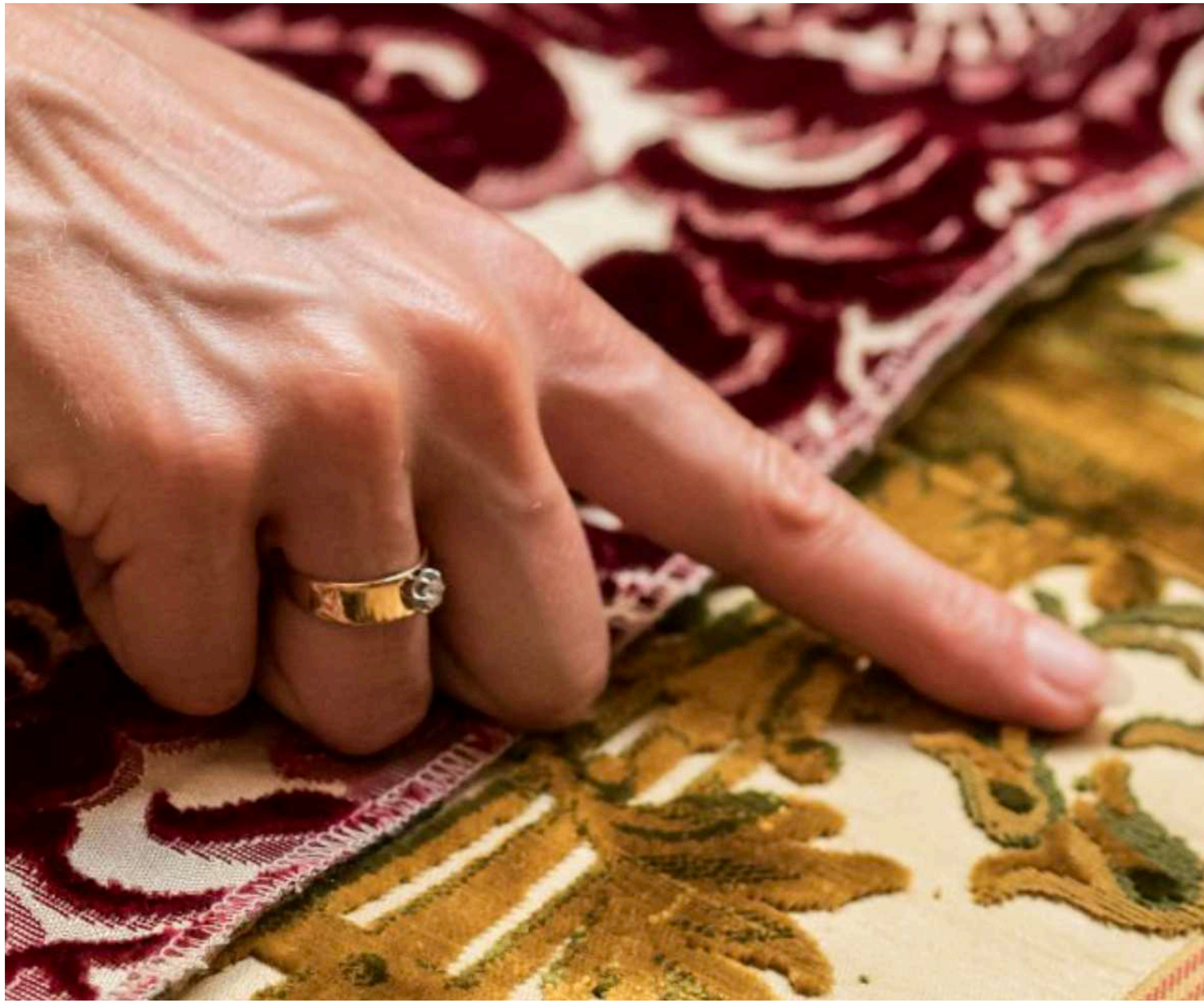

Here there will be the unique chance to experience a glass blowing demonstration and eventually buy some genuine pieces of art, real Murano glass pieces.

Usually after Murano, by boat, we hit another lovely island in the lagoon: [Burano](#). This island is well known for its colorful painted houses and for manufacturing of lovely laces and embroidery. That's why In Burano we will have another wonderful demonstration, from local artisans, showing stitches, needle point and final products.

In Burano there will be the time for a lunch (not included in the cost of the tour) and strolling around the island, exploiting it and taking a lot of wonderful pics. This island is like an unreal place, where people trust each other like in the good old days, front doors are never locked! A charming atmosphere surrounded by lovely little canals, magnificent colors, astonishing corners.

Usually, at the end of the tour, there's the time for vision another lovely tiny island, which [Mazzorbo](#). It's a little island attached to Burano by a wooden bridge, but it's really different and tiny compare to it. In Mazzorbo there will be the chance to visit a fantastic little unique vineyard, which fights for survival against the tides for 2 months each year. Have you ever imagined to find a vineyard in a tiny island in the middle of the lagoon?

Usually, at this point, 5 hours and a half are gone, and it's time to take the boat once again, and go back to Venice downtown, admiring the lagoon and its beauty. Once in Venice, the boat will dock at the hotel/ accommodation of tourists (where possible) or as close as it can. The tour guide will ensure the tourists are safe and sound back home or be left where they prefer.

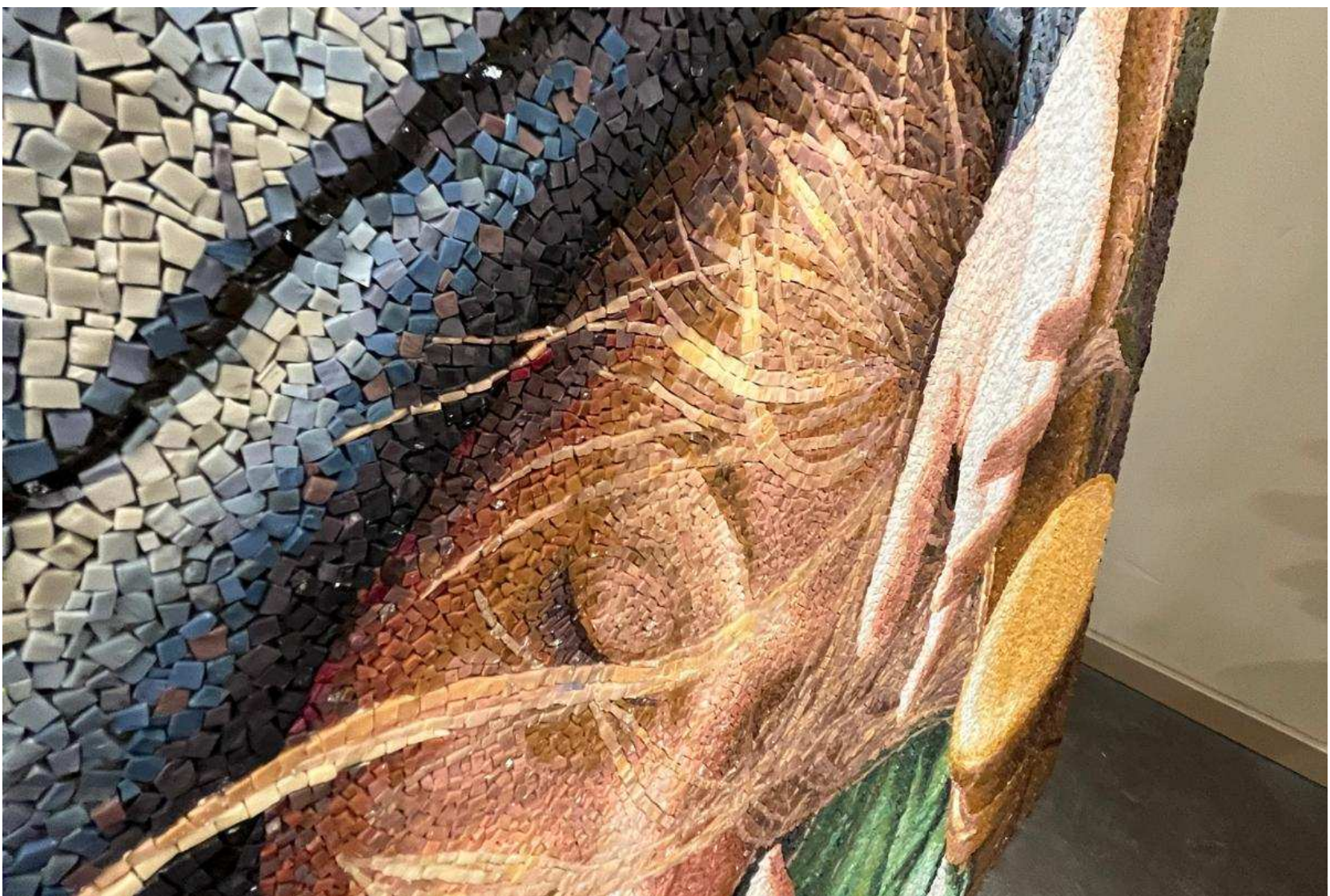

The time inside the glass factory including the demo is difficult to tell, but can go from 45 min to 3 or 4 hours ... it depends on clients . The factories we use are almost a museum/art gallery. I can tell you that an average visit is 1h 30 mins.

From Murano to Mazzorbo or Burano is about 20 mins ride

From Burano back to Venice is about 40 mins ride

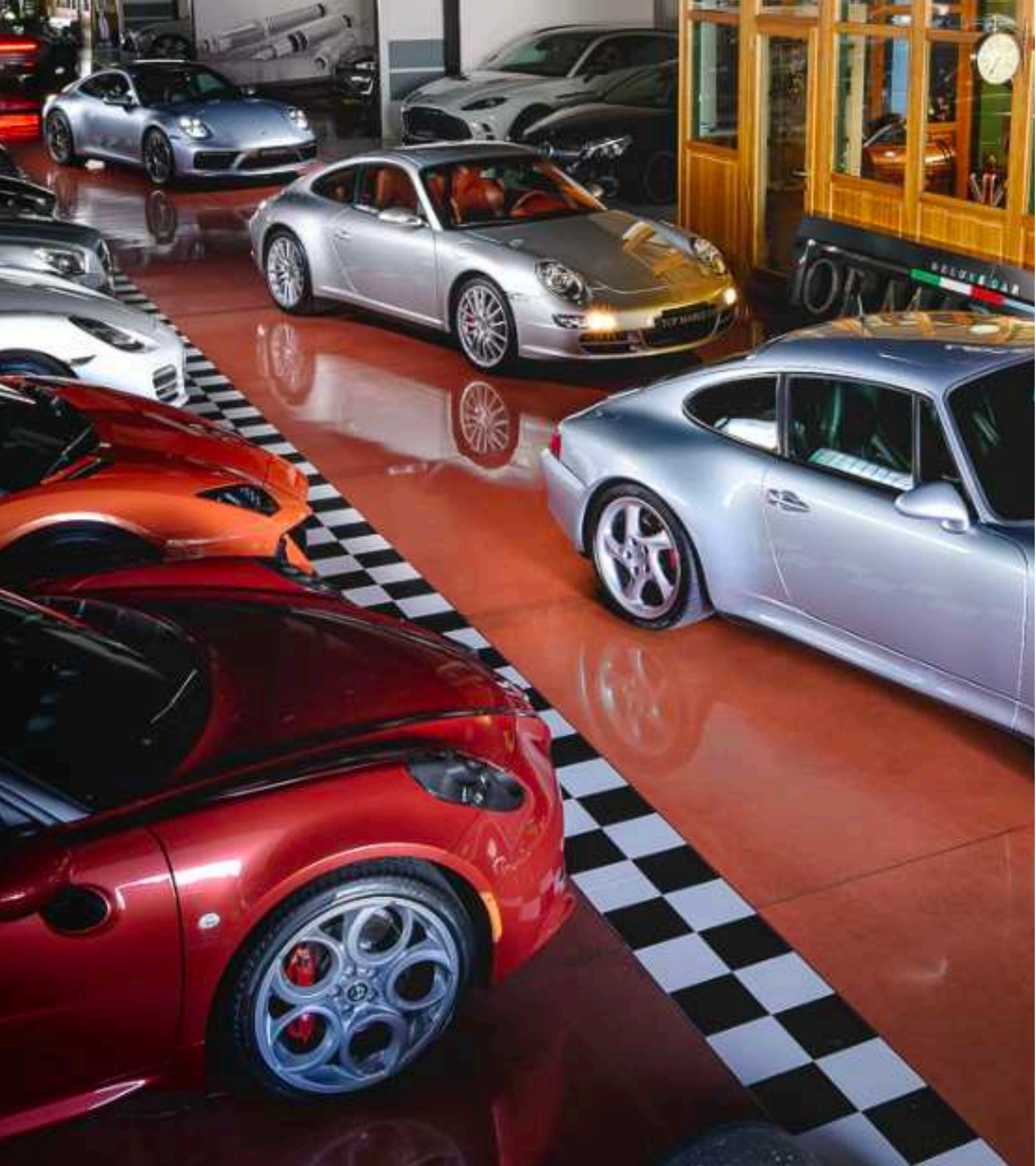

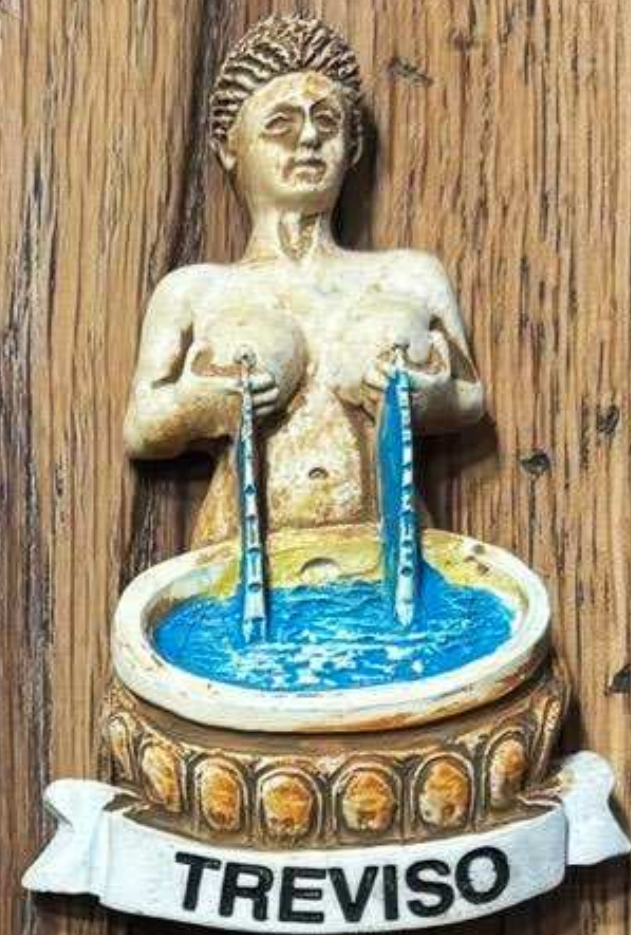

REMEMBER

Outdoor walking tour: if the group is starting from 10 people, it's mandatory use the radio system.

Walking tour including Basilica and Doges palace: we must use the radio system starting from group of 8 people.

Since 2024, groups must be no more than 25pax per local guide. If you do have a group with 50 people it must be split in 2 smaller groups and use the radio system.

From 18th April 2025 everybody must be registered in Venice. Even if you have got a reservation in an hotel in Venice, you need to register yourself in this website: <https://cda.ve.it/en/>
In this way you will get the free QR to access Venice downtown.

On the contrary, if you don't sleep in Venice and you are a day tripper, you must pay an entrance fee and no free QR code are available in this case.
